 - Responses received: 13 NSB, 2 RSB, 2 International SB
- Gender action plans
 - Group of actions laid down to articulate a change strategy for gender mainstreaming (programmatic and institutional priorities with concrete actions which can be measured)
 - Recommendation U establishes a set of 22 actions which can be integrated into GAP articulated around three themes
 - Gender balance (representativity)
 - Gender-responsive standards (resulting standards)
 - Gender-responsive standards bodies (internal transformation)
