# Main objective and expected outcomes of the Country Programme

## OUTCOME ONE

Identify opportunities for **reform** of Ukraine's existing environmental, waste and chemicals management policies.



## OUTCOME TWO

**Build capacity** on relevant environmental, waste and chemicals management areas.



## OBJECTIVE

Promote Ukraine's alignment and adherence with **OECD environmental instruments**, support implementation of **Ukraine's Post-war Recovery and Reconstruction Plan**, help in meeting Ukraine's **EU integration** requirements

- Decision-Recommendation on the Systematic Investigation of Existing Chemicals

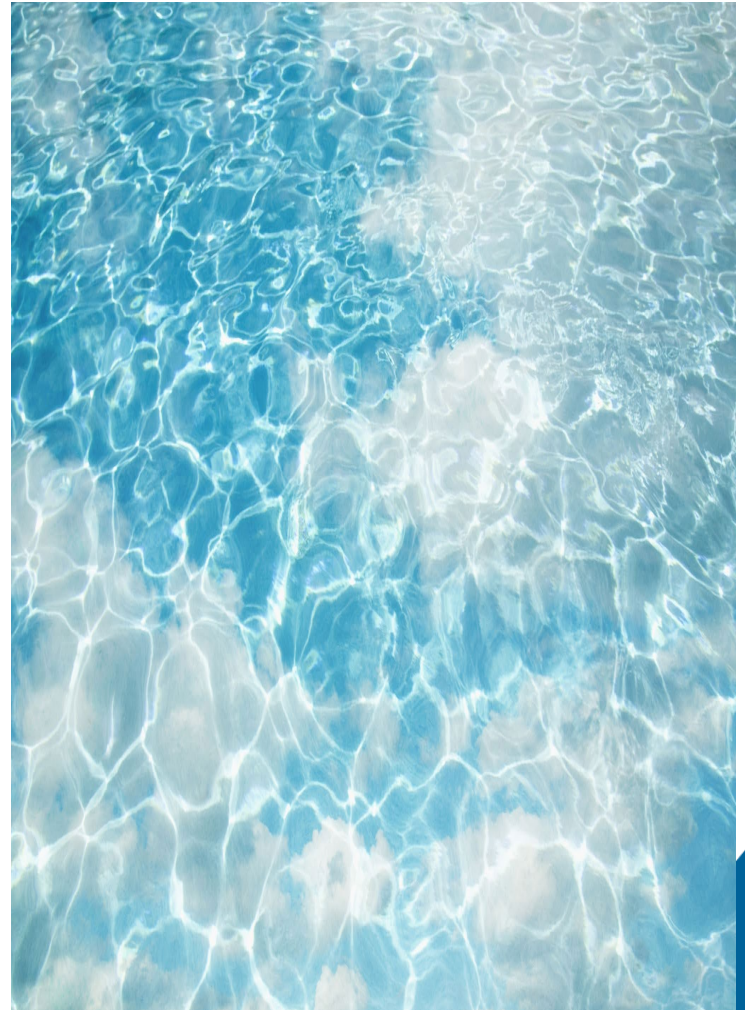


## Recommendation on Water ([OECD/LEGAL/0434](https://www.oecd.org/legal/0434))

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High-level policy guidance on topics relevant for water management and delivery of water services, including:

- managing water quantity;
- improving water quality;
- managing water risks and disasters;
- ensuring good water governance; and
- ensuring sustainable finance, investment and pricing for water and water services.





# Platform for Action on the Green Recovery of Ukraine

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- With UNEP and UNECE;
- To ensure that the recovery and development of Ukraine follows green economy and low-emission development principles;
- That these are not seen as only desirable or optional, but as an economic necessity for a fundamental transformation of Ukraine's economy and society;
- Define a green recovery for Ukraine also considering Ukraine as a candidate for EU accession;
- Support actions to prioritise and accelerate reform of policies and legislation, practices and institutions and to mobilise whole-of-government commitment for greening the post-war recovery;
- Support the development of amendments to the financial constitution and financial instruments which can facilitate the implementation of the Green Recovery Strategy;
- Support co-ordination and mobilisation of additional expertise and funding to promote a science-based, systemic and coordinated green recovery and set Ukraine on a net zero and climate-resilient development trajectory;
- Identify challenges and opportunities for strengthening the efficiency and effectiveness of international support in close co-operation with the already existing support formats.
