









### **FIRST MEETING**

# OF THE INTER-INSTITUTIONAL WORKING GROUP ON PREVENTION OF WATER POLLUTION AND TAILINGS SAFETY IN UZBEKISTAN<sup>1</sup>

### TASHKENT 24 September 2024, 9:00 – 12:30

#### **Background:**

The Inter-Institutional Working Group (IIWG), officially established on 26 July 2024 by the Decree of Mr. Aziz Abdukhakimov, the Minister of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan, is comprised of representatives of the various national authorities in charge of water management to environmental protection, industrial safety, sanitation, climate change, disaster risk reduction and emergency management. The IIWG provides a platform for long-term cooperation and coordination mechanism at national level. Following the high-level project launch event and technical workshop on 14 March 2024, the first IIWG meeting is being organized within the project on "Strengthening action in Uzbekistan on water and sanitation and protection of water resources from accidental pollution in the face of climate change". The project is implemented by UNECE and funded by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC).

#### **Objectives:**

- Familiarize with the Terms of Reference and composition of the IIWG;
- Discuss and agree on the IIWG workplan 2024-2025, including steering the project implementation, the timeline and next steps;
- Review current issues and necessary measures taken in the field of tailings safety and prevention of accidental water pollution;
- Deepen the understanding of benefits of the Industrial Accidents Convention;
- Discuss and agree on the next steps towards the development of a roadmap for accession to the Convention;
- Agree on the next steps towards the development of the Joint Contingency Plan framework in the Syr Darya River basin and other project activities;
- Enhance capacities of all relevant stakeholders dealing with industrial safety, disaster risk reduction, water resources, sanitation and related policy areas and strengthen cross-sectoral cooperation between all relevant actors.
