II. Proposed organization of the sessions: overview

- 1. The Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) and the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Strategic Environmental Assessment (Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol) will resume in conjunction in a single meeting room on 10 December 2024:
 - (a) The Meeting of the Parties to the Convention for its ninth session, resumed;
 - (b) The Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol for its fifth session, resumed.
- 2. Delegates will be invited to be present throughout the sessional period.
- 3. The high-level segment will resume at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 10 December 2024, and continue until 6 p.m. The resumed Meetings of the Parties will convene in joint and individual meetings, in sequence, including for the adoption of decisions and a declaration.

III. Annotations to the provisional agenda

High-level segment, resumed

1. Resuming the high-level segment

Tentative timing: Tuesday, 10 December, 10–10.10 a.m.

1. The high-level segment of the ninth session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention and the fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol will resume as a joint meeting. It will be resumed by the Chair of the Bureau.

2. Organizational matters

Tentative timing: Tuesday, 10 December, 10.10–10.30 a.m.

2. The Meetings of the Parties will then resume the joint meeting to address the organizational matters set out below.

(a) Status of officers for the high-level segment

3. The Meetings of the Parties, convened in a joint meeting, will be informed on the status of the officers for the high-level segment. It will then take action as necessary.

(b) Report of the Bureau

4. The Chair of the Bureau will inform the resumed Meetings of the Parties on the work of the Bureau during the intersessional period.

(c) Adoption of the agenda

(d) Report on credentials

6. According to rule 16 of the rules of procedure of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention (ECE/MP.EIA/2, annex I, decision I/1), which applies, mutatis mutandis, to the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol, the credentials of representatives of Parties, and the names of alternate representatives and advisers, are to be submitted to the secretariat if possible not later than 24 hours after the opening of the session. Any later change in the composition of the delegation must also be submitted to the secretariat. The credentials should be issued either by the Head of State, the Head of Government or the Minister for Foreign Affairs or, in the case of a regional economic integration organization, by the competent authority thereof. Only representatives of Parties with valid credentials² will be able to participate in the adoption of a decision or declaration. Parties are also invited to send

the secretariat a copy of the credentials³ two weeks prior to the session, that is to say, by 26 November 2024.

7. The Chairs will examine the credentials and report on them to the Meetings of the Parties (see rule 17 of the rules of procedure). The Meetings of the Parties will be invited to take note of the report on credentials of the representatives of Parties attending the Meetings of the Parties. Representatives may participate provisionally, pending this action.

(e) Status of the Convention and its amendments and the Protocol

The secretariat will inform participants about the status of ratification of the Convention, its two amendments and the Protocol since the ninth session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention and the fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (Geneva, 12–15 December 2023).
