## **TECHNICAL COOPERATION**

- 2019-2023: 138 projects with a total value of USD 352m identified
- Best funded types of intervention include:
  - ➢ Emergency Housing (USD 129, 907,778),
  - ➢ Facilitating and enabling projects (USD96,944,788),
  - ► Housing policy (USD 32,733,266), and
  - ➢ Aided self-help housing (USD29,547,936)
- Regional funding focused on Arab States (USD 212,393,339) and Africa (USD92,020,184)
- The top 10 countries: Iraq, Mozambique, Egypt, Lebanon, Lao PDR, Ghana, Syria, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Kenya.
- Projects mostly relatively small scale
- Need to diversify the portfolio across types of intervention and geography.
