Revision of global recommendations for the 2030 census round

Key themes – Revision of P&R

- Lessons learned, innovations and best practices from the 2020 round of censuses
- Increased role of geospatial information/tools
- **Evolving census methodologies**
- Increased leveraging of administrative data sources and data integration
- Contingency planning to make future censuses resilient lessons learned from COVID-19
- Harmonization with other international recommendations

Timeline of activities – Revision of P&R

- Ist EGM (23-25 May 2023)
 - First round of revisions
- 2nd EGM (13-15 Dec 2023)
 - Second round of revisions
- 3rd EGM (4-6 Sept 2024)
- Global consultation (Aug Sept 2024)
- Final review and editing (Oct Nov 2024)
- Submit 4th revision of P&R for approval by Statistical Commission (56th Session, March 2025)

Relationship of PHC with administrative data (New)

CRVS, population register, building/address register, business register, other admin data sources

Data integration (New)

Census data with geospatial information & with administrative sources

Methodology

- Three broad categories, along with their variants
- Methods for estimating population for areas not enumerated in the census (admin data, sample surveys, modelled methods) (*New*)
- Strategies for producing more frequent PH statistics (admin data, intercensal surveys, annual continuous surveys, mobile phone data) (*New*)

Planning

- Reference to the GSBPM align census operations to the 8 phases of GSBPM (New)
- Considerations when planning a combined or register-based PHC (New)
- Innovations to optimize PHC processes: technology, administrative data, geospatial information, data integration, etc. (*New*)

Geospatial information in census operations

- Recognize the intrinsic value of geospatial information—not just as a means of supporting PHCs
- Emphasis on partnership & institutional collaboration between NSOs and national geospatial information agencies (NGIAs)
- Update references to "mapping" throughout the publication to conform to the contemporary
 practice of collecting and analyzing geospatial information in databases first and then producing
 maps as products

Field enumeration

- Multimode data collection: design and management
- Use of administrative data for field-based census enumerations (New)
- Security during data collection (New)

Data processing

- Coding: role of AI and ML
- Use of administrative data during data processing for field-based censuses (New)
- Security during data processing (New)

Dissemination and utilization

- Development of dissemination strategy key elements
- Confidentiality and privacy: considerations for tabular data, interactive data explorers, map/geospatial information
- Metadata geospatial metadata (New)
- Geographic products grid-based census outputs, smart maps, geoportals, etc. (New)

Quality assurance and evaluation

- References UN National Quality Assurance Framework and its principles not only for addressing census processes and outputs, but also the need to manage the census with the context of the institutional environment of the NSO and the broader national statistical system (New)
- Quality improvement of census processes geospatial information, development of data capture systems for CPAI & CAWI, testing, field operations, processing, analysis
- Measuring the quality of census data derived from administrative sources (New)
- Evaluation of census results adjusting census data (for field-based, combined, register-based), acceptance of the results, user satisfaction surveys (New)

New / revised population and housing census topics

Population census topics

- Internal migration: reason for change of residence (New)
- Urban/rural: definition according to DEGURBA (New)
- International migration: ever resided abroad, reason for international migration (New)
- Registration of vital events and assignment of legal identity (New)
- Use of ICT at individual level: individuals using the Internet, individuals owning mobile cellular phone (*New*)
- Economic characteristics: status in employment (according to type of authority) ??
- Agriculture: size of farm and number of livestock (New) ??

Housing census topics

 Availability of ICT (at the household level): household having a computer, household with Internet access ??
