| Summary: <i>This presentation explores the integration of wealth into the standard EU-SILC measure of at risk of poverty or social exclusion (AROPE) in Finland. We use data from the 2020 EU-SILC survey, which included a six-year module on consumption, wealth, and indebtedness. In addition, in Finland it included a comprehensive measure of household net wealth constructed for the ECB Household Finance and Consumption Survey (HFCS wave 4). This integration of EU-SILC and HFCS allows us to assess and compare the differences in assets-based poverty between the relatively limited wealth content in EU-SILC, and the broader net wealth captured in HFCS. We introduce several HFCS-derived assets-based poverty measures as an additional dimension to the EU-SILC AROPE indicator and compare them with assets-based poverty measures derived solely using the EU-SILC module variables. The aim is to provide insights into the types of wealth data that could improve the understanding of poverty and social exclusion in Finland.</i> | |
