Background

- * IWG proposed by Australia at 127th session of GRSG (April 2024).
 - Documents GRSG-127-09 & GRSG-127-10.
- * Objective is to develop two new regulations on:
 - Driver Drowsiness Warning Systems
 - Driver Distraction Warning Systems
- Proposal supported by GRSG, with interest in developing both UN regulations and GTRs.
- ❖ Proposal endorsed by WP.29 at the 193rd session in June 2024.

Meeting 1 held 7th October 2024

- * Meeting 1 held this week in Geneva as a hybrid meeting.
- * Meeting was attended by 48 participants, with representatives from Australia, China, France, Finland, Germany, Japan, Korea, Netherlands, Sweden, UK, USA, CLEPA, IRF, OICA, JAMA.
- * Australia has taken the role of chair (Dr Linda Rasmussen).
- OICA has taken the role of Secretariat (Mr. Simone Bambagioni).

Meeting 1 held 7th October 2024 (cont'd)

- ❖ Draft Terms of Reference were agreed to with some additional edits.
 - Terms regarding GTR development to be reviewed during GRSG.
- ❖ Draft Task List covering the major tasks that could be performed by the IWG were discussed and given in-principle support.
- ❖ Initial discussions were held regarding the technical basis for the new regulations, including a proposed staged approach of 00 series mostly aligned to EU Regulations, followed by improved 01
- Schedule of proposed future meetings (next four) were agreed to.
