Summary:

The presentation provides a set of statistical indicators measuring household energy resource accessibility within Kyrgyzstan, as developed by the National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic. The indicators focus on evaluating sustainable energy access through specific metrics: Proportion of Population with Access to Electricity (SDG 7.1.1); Proportion of Population Primarily Using Clean Fuels and Technology (SDG 7.1.2), and the sub-indicators Proportion of Population Utilizing Clean Fuels for Heating (Indicator 7.1.2a) and Cooking (Indicator 7.1.2b). The data is disaggregated by region, urban/rural areas, gender, age, and education level.

Together, these indicators are intended to provide a view of household energy sustainability, emphasizing access disparities and potential areas for policy intervention.

The second section of the presentation provides a brief outputs from the Household survey on energy vulnerability, conducted in February-March 2024 by UNDP during the process of the preparation of National Human Development report on energy induced vulnerabilities 2023/2024.
