Update & planned activities







Envisaged upgrade of the IAN System

- Overview
 - Upgrading the IAN System to be more secure and user-friendly, and address bugs which were raised during previous consultations
- Status & next step
 - Currently in discussion with two UN service providers on options, incl. options to meet the allocated amount from contributions made by the European Union and Switzerland
 - To decide on the service provider in coming months, and to pursue upgrade in 2025
 - EIB providing a consultant to develop a video to increase awareness of the new IAN System and training manual for users
 - Upgraded system planned to be presented at the UNECE/UNDRR/WMO Global seminar on early warning and industrial accident notification, environmental liability and pollution remediation (2025)

Resources

- European Union support to upgrade
- Switzerland support annually for maintenance
- More resources required to more comprehensively upgrade/modernize the system



Consultations with Points of Contact

- No consultation organized this biennium due to limited funding and since the system is planned to be upgrade in 2025, including on the basis of feedback consolidated from past consultations and tests
- New test and consultation planned for 2025, linked with system's upgrade
